4 Types of Opportunities

Time (Cost) Savings



- SP amendment time savings of about 20 minutes per submission resulted in a cost savings in PG Division of **100 hrs** last year.
- FG declarations were sped up substantially in the 2006 submissions. Submission time was reduced by about 56 minutes/submission. This saved PG Division an estimated **236 hrs** last year.
- Not having to re-send lost submissions for SP's, and MLSIS is expected to save at least **10 hrs/year**.
- CP applications used to take about 3 hours to send off, now they take minutes. About 115 applications /year saving about **300 hrs/year**.

Leveraging Data



- While we have always strived to have good data quality, moving to e-submissions forced more consistent data to be stored in our system.
- Conducting analysis on this reliable data presents endless possibilities to Licensees.
 - Risk and cost analysis by ecology
 - Ingress analysis by ecology and timber type
 - SFM monitoring for productivity and species diversity.

Access to MoFR consolidated data



- Timely access to online data has helped with corporate reporting
 - Area FG, SR, and NSR
 - # of trees planted last year
 - Seed inventory by Species
- Up-to-Date mapping for all tenures allowed us to see proposed land status changes to the provincial forest.
- Compliance checks for Late Free Growing and Regeneration Delay.

Consistent MoFR Submissions and Data Tracking



- All submissions are date stamped. These dates can be tracked very easily. I feel the turn around from the MoFR is faster now than it used to be.
 - Some approvals are in hours now instead of weeks or months.
- Submissions cannot get lost on the corner of somebody's desk.
- Every Forest District had different requirements for submissions in the past. RESULTS gives us a consistent framework for submissions which we can make consistent business processes for.
